

Motion for the 2019 Annual General Meeting

Reduce the GMC to Ten.

The General Management Committee should shrink from its current maximum 16 members to 10. The quorum for meetings remains 7.

The objective is to make the committee more efficient. Proposed new structure:

- 1 Chair
- 2 Treasurer
- 3 Club Secretary
- 4 Bar Secretary
- 5 Tennis Secretary
- 6 Tennis member
- 7 Second tennis member
- 8 Squash Secretary
- 9 Squash Member
- 10 Second Squash member

The new smaller committee would come in operation from the 2020 AGM. This motion assumes the new size is sufficient to represent Club members well, but is easier to manage.

This motion requires a change in the Articles of Association and therefore requires a 75% majority to be successful.

The Article change proposed is

In Part 2 Article 2.1 delete the first sentence and substitute "The General Management Committee (the "Committee") shall consist of the Chair, Treasurer, Club Secretary, Bar Secretary, Tennis Secretary, two tennis members, Squash Secretary and two squash members."
